Nebraska Master Naturalist Program 2017 Third Quarter Report



By The Numbers: In this quarter, Nebraska Master Naturalists have **contributed** 2,055 hours of volunteer time valued at \$48,435 in conservation service. In their efforts, Nebraska Master Naturalists have **connected** with **22,912** Nebraskans and has **impacted 2,521** acres across the state in direct conservation work. Since tracking began in fall 2010, Master Naturalists have contributed a total of 52,950 volunteer service hours valued at **\$1,247,502**.

Highlighted Events: Nebraska Master Naturalist members have been active volunteering and engaging in several educational training opportunities around the state this quarter. Each quarter we like to highlight a few standout events. In July over a dozen Master Naturalists, participated in the 2nd annual Bug Masters training held in Lincoln at Entomology Hall. Bug Masters has been a great partnership and opportunity for our members to be trained in insect identification and educational outreach methods. In August the Master Naturalist program partnered with Fontenelle Forest in Bellevue to host a two-day workshop focused on bats, small mammal and insect identification. August was also busy for Master Naturalists with the many Solar Eclipse events happening around the state. Our Naturalists were valuable assets in providing volunteer and educational outreach support for our partners that hosted events. In early September our monthly continuing education event was Biodiversity Celebration: Nebraska's Unique Landscapes Time-lapse. This was a two-year project that Master Naturalist Adrian Olivera and program Instructor Bill Beachly have developed to further inspire others about our unique state. To round out this quarter we hosted our final training of 2017 with our Fall core training held at the Crane Trust, welcoming a dozen more members to the program.

Outreach: We have been very fortunate this quarter to be involved in several outreach events around the state. In July we were invited to host an outreach booth and present our program at the Sandhills Discovery Conference in Anisworth. In July we were also onsite at LES (Lincoln Electric System) Sustainable Living Festival. This was a great opportunity to reach out to youth and family attending the event. In September several Master Naturalists represented the program while they volunteered in the Nebraska building with Nebraska Game & Parks Commission. Additionally, we were on hand for the third year in a row at Nebraska Game & Parks annual Missouri River Expo at Ponca State Park. This is always an outstanding weekend for Nebraska Master Naturalist Program Outreach and volunteerism, connecting Nebraskans with our natural heritage.

What is Ahead: New beginnings for the Nebraska Master Naturalist Program are in store, as in October we will host our first ever stand-alone Master Naturalist Conference in conjunction with the Nebraska Natural Legacy Conference. This event, hosted at the Lied Lodge in Nebraska city, will bring together naturalist members and program partners, sharing special projects and accomplishments, as well as recruiting and collaborating on upcoming volunteer and partner projects. In addition, our 2018 Training dates have been set, we will host trainings in the spring at Prairie Pines, Pioneers Park in June at the Nature Conservancy's Niobrara Valley Preserve and in July at Cedar Point Biological station, then back at the Crane trust in September. Furthermore, the 2018 Nebraska Naturalist calendar will be soon available. This is the third year, that this Naturalist Member initiated project has come together to create a beautiful and educational product. The end of 2017 looks to be another great season for the advancement of the Nebraska Master Naturalist Program.

By The Numbers: In this quarter, Nebraska Master Naturalists have **contributed** 2,055 hours of volunteer time valued at \$48,435 in conservation service. In their efforts, Nebraska Master Naturalists have **connected** with **22,912** Nebraskans and has **impacted 2,521** acres across the state in direct conservation work. Since tracking began in fall 2010, Master Naturalists have contributed a total of 52,950 volunteer service hours valued at \$1,247,502.

Highlighted Projects: This quarter our Nebraska Master Naturalist members have been active in several citizen science and resource management projects around the state, each having an impact on the unique landscapes and species in those areas. In Eastern Nebraska, a duo of naturalists has been actively surveying the Butterfly species that pass though Lauritzen Gardens and Fontenelle Forest. This project titled "Butterflies in Season" was initiated in 2015 and has plans to go indefinitely. The data collected has and will continue to provide information to those organizations on what species they have, when they come and go and what host species offer the best habit. Additionally, Master Naturalists have participated in other Citizen Science research projects such as a Plains Pocket Mice Study. This data is being collected in Central Nebraska and shared with Nebraska Game and Parks commission to further document and understand this creature's life history, range and habitat.

Furthermore, several Master Naturalist have been a part of the North American Bat Survey. This project based out of UNL's Nebraska Cooperative Fish and Wildlife Unit, purpose is to use innovative acoustical sensing equipment to survey bat species and their populations in over 20 locations in Nebraska. This has been a rewarding project that Nebraska Master Naturalist got to be on the ground floor of.

Other projects that have induced Master Naturalist involvement this quarter include: Monarch & Regal Fritillary Butterfly Surveying with Nebraska Game & Parks. Resource Management in the removal of Cedar trees in the Aspen stand at Smith Falls State Park area to aid Aspen trees with growth and health opportunities. Removing honey locust and other woody plants in upland prairie at Audubon's Spring Creek Prairie.

What is Ahead: We have several projects in the works with Master Naturalists members collaborating with our partner agencies to meet their goals. For example, the Greater Nebraska group of Master Naturalists are teaming up with The Nature Conservancy in Nebraska, to produce a second edition of their successful "Guide to Central Nebraska Prairies". This easy to hold and read field guide provides basic information for the reader to be able to identify the unique plant and animal species found in Central Nebraska. As well as provide details on conservation of these special ecosystems and the at-risk species found within. The audience for the guide will be, students, teachers, scout groups, naturalists, and anyone with an interest in discovering prairie areas in Central Nebraska.

In addition, we have a Master Naturalist member volunteering on behalf of our program partner, Heron Haven that is developing an education field book titled "The Wonders of Heron Haven". This field book is intended for visitors of Heron Haven to develop an understanding of the water resources, and ecosystem service that the wetlands provide as well as the wide variety of plants, animals and bird species that call Heron Haven home. This goal of this guide to provide an educational tool that will lead to conservation minded public.
